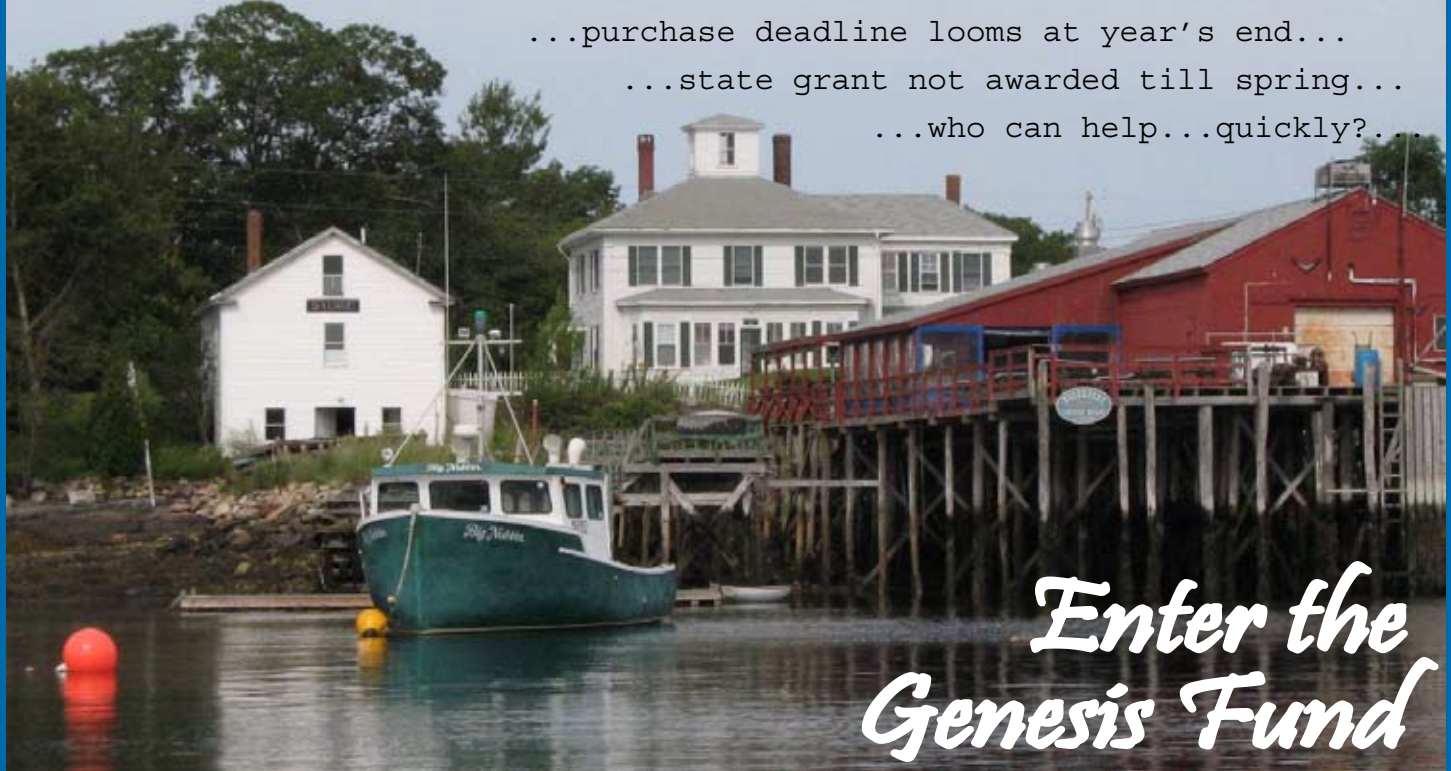

Now owned by the Holbrook Community Foundation, it is preserved as a community center, offering protected access to the coast for local fishermen.
